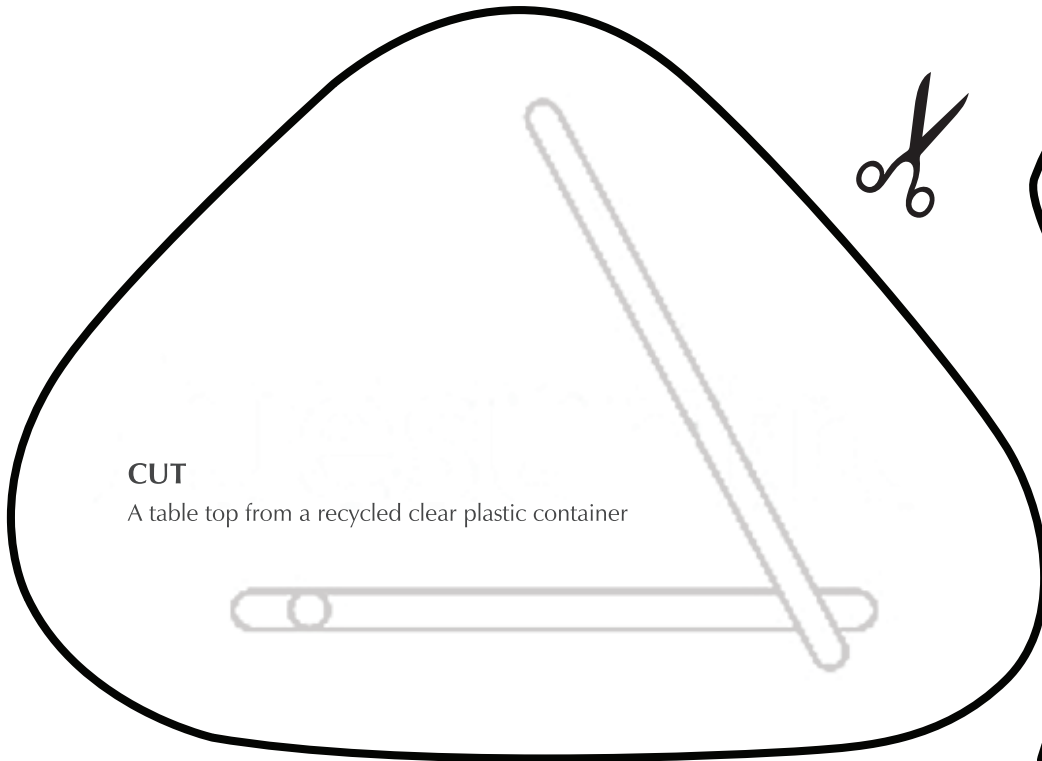
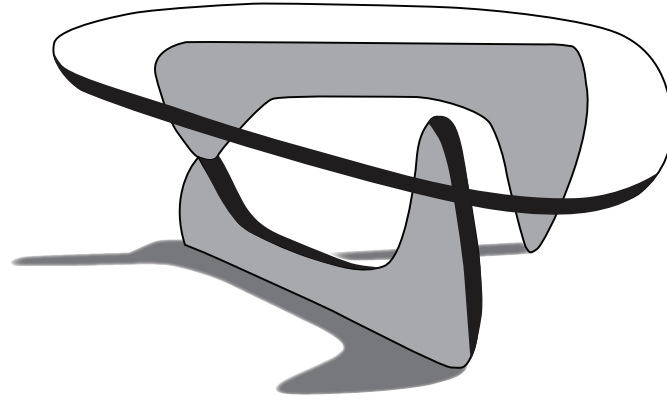


Isamu Noguchi used **free form** and **geometric shapes** in his furniture design. Find pictures of his designs on the web—tables, sofas, and more.

Use scissors to cut recycled materials (clear plastic containers and cardboard) to make a mini “glass” table like Noguchi’s. Follow the pattern pieces below. The light gray lines on the table top pattern show where the table supports are placed. Use glue to secure the pieces together.

Invent more mini-furniture pieces using different shapes.

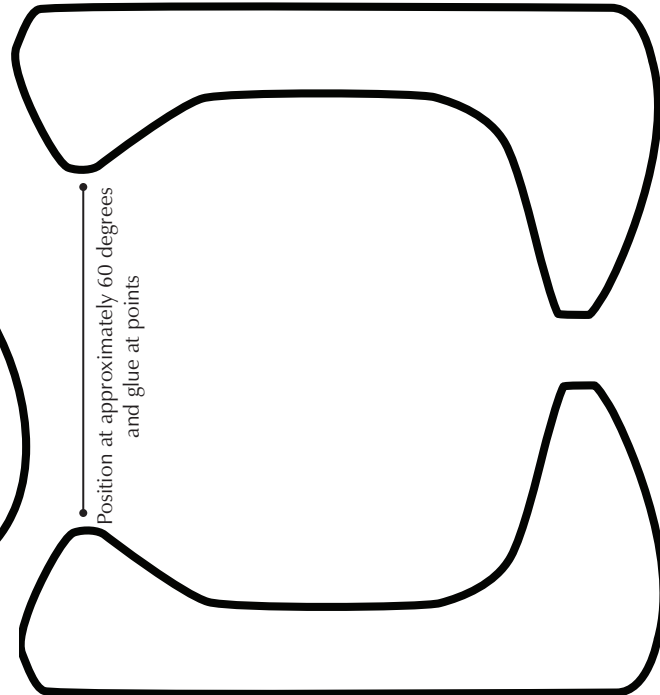


CUT
